

WHAT ARE SOME SIGNS OF **AUTISM?**

- * **Have trouble relating to others** *or not have interest in relating to others at all.*
- * **avoid eye contact and want to be alone.**
- * **prefer not to be held or cuddled** *or might cuddle only when they want to.*
- * **appear to be unaware when other people talk** *to them but responds to other sounds.*
- * **Have trouble expressing their needs** *using typical words or motions.*
- * **Laugh, cry, or show distress** *for no apparent reason.*
