



Financial Information

The Autism Society of North Carolina focuses resources on high quality programming to improve the lives of individuals with autism and their families. Our program and service revenue covers only a portion of our expenses, and we rely on donor giving to bridge the gap. For every dollar raised, 89 cents goes directly to funding services.

The 2015-2016 annual operating budget was just over \$19,200,000.



Revenues for the organization come from a variety of sources including Medicaid reimbursable services, contracts with the state of North Carolina, grants, donations, corporate sponsorships, special events and fundraisers, and sales of autism books and merchandise.



The Autism Society of North Carolina operates on a fiscal year of July 1 - June 30. Financial reports are reviewed by the Chief Financial Officer and the Finance Committee of the Board of Directors. Further, the organization undergoes an annual accounting audit by an outside auditor as well as periodic reviews by government agencies.
