



IGNITE Greensboro Fee Q&A

What is the schedule? IGNITE Greensboro operates 40 hours per week M-F with day and evening hours available and offers 2 weekend activities per month. The year is broken into 2 semesters of 6 months each (Jan-June and July-Dec). The fee for each semester is \$1500.00 or \$250 per month.

How do I make the payment? Once accepted, you will receive an invoice and options for payment. Payments can be made in: a) 3 payments of \$500 b) session installments of \$1500 or c) a single annual payment of \$3000.

Payments are due by the 1st of the month.

The semester started in July but I am being accepted in September, do I still owe \$1500 for the semester? No. Tuition is pro-rated. IGNITE Greensboro offers rolling enrollment, meaning openings are filled as they become available.

What if I can only come 2 days a week? Is my tuition adjusted? No, the fee is \$1500 per semester and you can choose to come for everything offered or for the days and times that meet your needs and schedule. We encourage members to take advantage of as many of the activities as possible.

If I am no longer able to attend IGNITE Greensboro, or decide to discontinue my membership, what do I need to do? If you leave the program, you must submit in writing (email or letter) that you wish to end your membership. Once the letter is received, your last day of membership will be the last day of that month. Session fees are non-refundable. If you decide you want to rejoin IGNITE in the future, you must re-apply, and may be put on the waiting list for admittance.

Can I apply for a scholarship? The Autism Society of North Carolina has limited funding to support scholarships for IGNITE. Scholarship awards are based on financial need and funds available.

What happens if I miss a payment? Please notify the program if your payment will be late. We must receive notice in advance of missed payments to maintain memberships.

Are there any additional fees? Yes. Part of the IGNITE experience includes activities in the community (going out to dinner, movies, etc.). Members are expected to pay for their own meals and activities in the community. Our goal is to have free or low-cost activities twice per month. However, based on the members' interests, the activity costs may be up to \$20. If an activity exceeds \$15, every effort will be made to keep the other activity that month free or very low cost.
