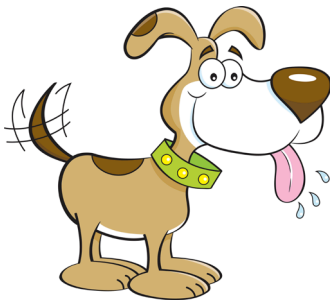


Getting a New Dog
