



Summer Day Camp Dates 2019

Day Camp operates on a first come, first served basis. Campers will have the option to go online to our registration page during the application period and register for multiple weeks, based on availability. Hours are 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Thursday and 9 a.m.-2:30 p.m. Friday.

- June 3-7: Adults (18+ years of age), all levels
- June 10-14: School-age campers (4-22 years), all levels
- June 17-21: School-age campers (4-22 years), all levels
- June 24-28: School-age campers (4-22 years), all levels
- July 1-5: Teens (13-22 years), with HFA/Asperger's*
- July 8-12: Kids (6-12 years), with HFA/Asperger's*
- July 15-19: School-age campers (4-22 years), all levels
- July 22-26: School-age campers (4-22 years), all levels
- July 29-August 2: School-age campers (4-22 years), all levels
- August 5-9: School-age campers (4-22 years), all levels

*High-Functioning Criteria: Language should be comprehensible by others and appropriate to age level. Adolescents and children should be able to participate in group activities that require conversation skills, follow verbal directions, and participate in simple discussions, and be supervised in a group of one counselor with two or three campers. Adolescents should be independent in all daily living skills (toileting, bathing, dressing, etc.) and be able to be supervised in a group of four. New applicants applying for this week will be screened by camp staff and will not be eligible to attend this week without screening in advance.
