



Summer Residential Camp Dates 2021

Weeks are divided by age and level of ability so that we can provide the most suitable activities for each camper. You can apply for your preferred weeks; we will make every effort to accommodate you. Campers can attend for only one week of Residential Camp during the summer. Campers may attend more than one week of Day Camp. Campers attending Residential Camp arrive on Sunday afternoon and stay until Friday afternoon.

- June 6-11: Adults (18+ years), all levels
- June 13-18: Adults (18+ years), all levels
- June 20-25: Kids (4-12 years), all levels
- June 27-July 2: Kids/Teens (10-14 years), all levels
- July 4-9: Teens (13-19 years), with HFA/Asperger's* and Assistant Activity Directors, adults (18+ years), with HFA/Asperger's**
- July 11-16: Kids (7-12 years), with HFA/Asperger's* and Assistant Activity Directors, adults (18+ years), with HFA/Asperger's**
- July 18-23: Teens (13-19 years), all levels
- July 25-30: Kids (4-12 years), all levels
- August 1-6: Teens (13-19 years), all levels
- August 8-13 Adults (18+ years), with HFA/Asperger's*

*High-Functioning Criteria: Language should be comprehensible by others and appropriate to age level. Adolescents and children should be able to participate in group activities that require conversation skills, follow verbal directions, and participate in simple discussions, and be supervised in a group of one counselor with two or three campers. Adolescents and adults should be independent in all daily living skills (toileting, bathing, dressing, etc.) and be able to be supervised in a group of four. New applicants applying for this week will be screened by camp staff and will not be eligible to attend this week without screening in advance.

** Assistant Activity Directors: A limited number of Assistant Activity Director Positions are offered at Camp Royall for adults with HFA/Asperger's who are able to work independently with minimal supervision. If you do not contact the camp office, you will not be considered for an Assistant Activity Director position.
