


The Solar Eclipse



On Monday, August 21, we will be able to see a solar eclipse.



A solar eclipse is when the moon blocks the sun's light. Eclipses can block all of the sun's light or just some of it.

The eclipse on Monday will be a total eclipse. In some towns, it will be dark outside for a couple of minutes. The last time a total solar eclipse could be seen in the U.S. was almost 40 years ago.



Our eyes cannot look at the sun. It is not safe. We need to wear special glasses to see the eclipse.
